World Rabies Day 2008: Quiz on Rabies

[Planned Outline]

Preliminaries (Selection round / Screening test)

Venue: LECTURE HALL – II

1. All registered teams will take a written MCQs test. Both members of the team shall participate as one team. Each team will have one of them as team leader who shall finally decide on behalf of the team and sign documents whenever needed.
2. The Question Paper will have 30 MCQs.
3. Each MCQ shall have four alternatives with one of them being the correct answer.
4. Each correct answer shall be awarded two marks.
5. One mark will be deducted for every wrong answer.
6. Thirty (30) minutes (for a 30 MCQs paper) shall be given for the written test carrying a maximum of 60 marks.
7. In case of a tie ten extra questions (Ten minutes duration) will be asked. Each correct answer carries plus (+) two marks and a wrong answer minus (-) two marks. All questions are compulsory and a non attempt to answer a question will carry minus (-) one mark.
8. The top eight teams based on the highest marks obtained shall qualify for the semi final round.

Selection and Grouping of teams for Semi Final Rounds

- The eight teams selected will then be ranked from 1 to 8 according to highest marks obtained. Teams 1, 3, 5&7 will be included in Group-I, and similarly teams 2, 4, 6& 8 will be in Group-II.
- Two separate question paper sets shall be given in the semifinals and allocation of question paper sets to the two groups will be done randomly.

The group – II will have the inherent advantage of being in the audience while the group – I participates in the quiz programme.

Two Semi finals (45 Minutes Duration Each)

Venue: Lecture Hall-I

Group-I & Group-II

**Each group will have 4 teams (each team having 2 persons)
[2 persons X 4 teams = 8 persons]**

- * The group I will go through the semifinal round first followed by group II.
- **There are four rounds in this stage.**
- **There are 4 questions in each round, so that each team gets 4 direct questions.**
- **For each question 10 seconds time will be given to answer.**
- **Only one answer, that too first answer is considered.**
- **The correct answer will be awarded 10 marks.**
- **The top two teams based on highest marks obtained shall qualify from each group (of 4 teams) for the finals.**
- **If there is a tie, there will be a buzzer round .The tied teams shall have an equal opportunity to participate in this round. The team which hits the buzzer first shall answer .If the answer is wrong the team loses.**

The following is the pattern of questions for the semifinal.

I. Scramble

Time: 10seconds/question

(Unscramble the word and give the right word)

Correct answer: 10 Marks, Wrong answer: Zero and no negative marks.

The question will be passed to audience. The person in the audience answering correctly will get one Cadbury's chocolate.

II. MCQ type of questions.

Time: 10 seconds/question

**Correct answer: 10 Marks,
Wrong answer and No answer: Minus (negative) 5 Marks.**

The question will not be passed.

III. Direct question

Time: 10 seconds/question

Correct answer: 10 Marks, No Negative Marks.

The question shall pass to the next team. 5 marks will be awarded for the right answer.

If no team answers, the question shall pass to the audience. The person in the audience answering correctly will get one Cadbury's chocolate.

IV. Guess the word/s.

Time: 10 seconds/question

(Only select letters shall be provided.)

If the team answers correctly: 10 Marks.

No marks shall be awarded if the answer is wrong. No Negative Marks.

The question shall pass to the audience. The person in the audience answering correctly will get one Cadbury's chocolate.

Final (One Hour Duration).

**Finals will have 4 teams (each team having 2 persons)
[2 persons X 4 teams = 8 persons]**

Venue: Lecture Hall-I

- There are five rounds in this stage.
- There are 4 questions in each round, so that each team gets 4 direct questions.
- Only one answer that too first answer is considered.
- For correct answer you will get 10 marks.
- 10 seconds time will be given to answer.
- Based on the highest marks obtained the winner and runner up teams will be declared.

The Following is the pattern of questions for the finals.

I. Direct question.

Time: 10 seconds/question

Correct answer: 10 Marks, wrong answer: Zero & No Negative Marks

The question will not be passed.

The Question shall pass to the audience. The person in the audience answering correctly will get one Cadbury's chocolate.

II. Pick the Chit and answer.

Time: 10 seconds/question

(Chits 1-5 are written and the team is asked to choose one Chit (A question from any of the above format).

Correct answer: 10 Marks, Wrong answer: Zero and No negative marks.

The question shall pass to the next team. 5 Marks will be awarded for the right answer.

If no team answers correctly the Question shall pass to the audience. The person in the audience answering correctly will get one Cadbury's chocolate.

III. Picture round.

Time: 10 seconds/question

[See the picture and answer the question]

Correct Answer: 10 marks, wrong answer zero and No negative marks

The question will not be passed.

The question shall go to the audience. The person in the audience answering correctly will get one Cadbury's chocolate.

IV. Rapid fire round:

Time: 60 Seconds/Team

(Each team shall answer a maximum 6 direct questions in 60 seconds.)

For each correct answer the team is awarded 5 marks, No negative Marks for wrong answer.

V. Buzzer Round

Time: 10 seconds /question

All the teams shall have an equal opportunity to participate in this round. There shall be five questions in this round. The questions can be from any of the above format. The team which hits the buzzer first shall answer.

Correct answer: 10 Marks, Wrong answer minus10 marks.

The question shall not be passed

If no team answers, the question shall pass to the audience. The person in the audience answering correctly will get one Cadbury's chocolate.

If there is a tie we will have special buzzer round .The tied teams shall have an equal opportunity to participate in this round. The team which hits the buzzer first shall answer. If the answer is wrong the team loses.

Note: The quiz structure may change due to organizational reasons at the last minute; but adequate notice will be given to the participants before the event about the change(s) made.
